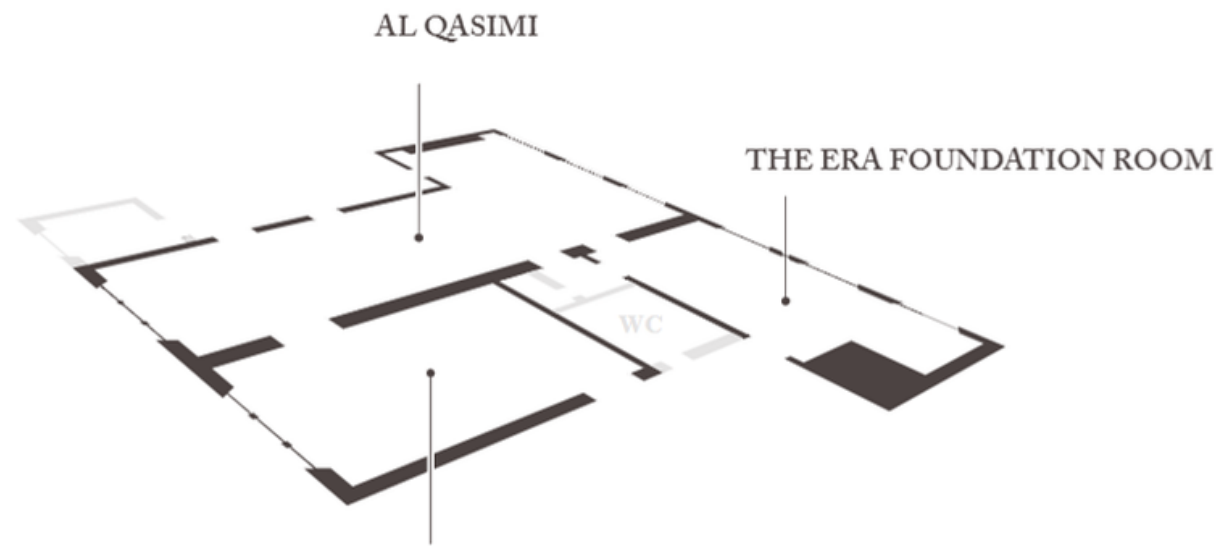

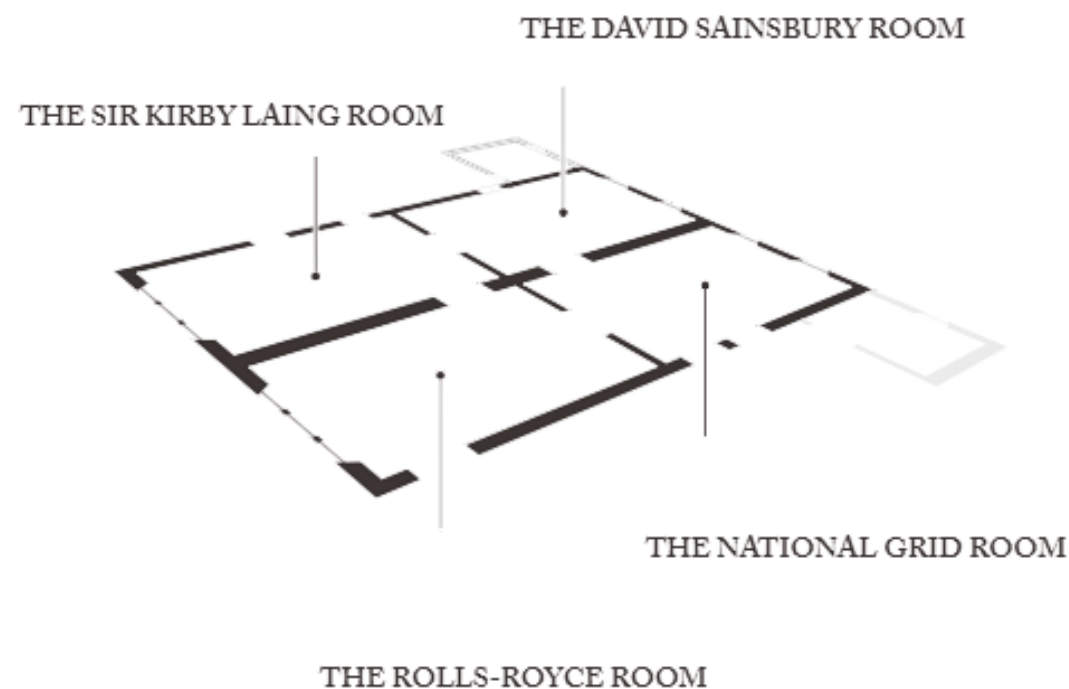

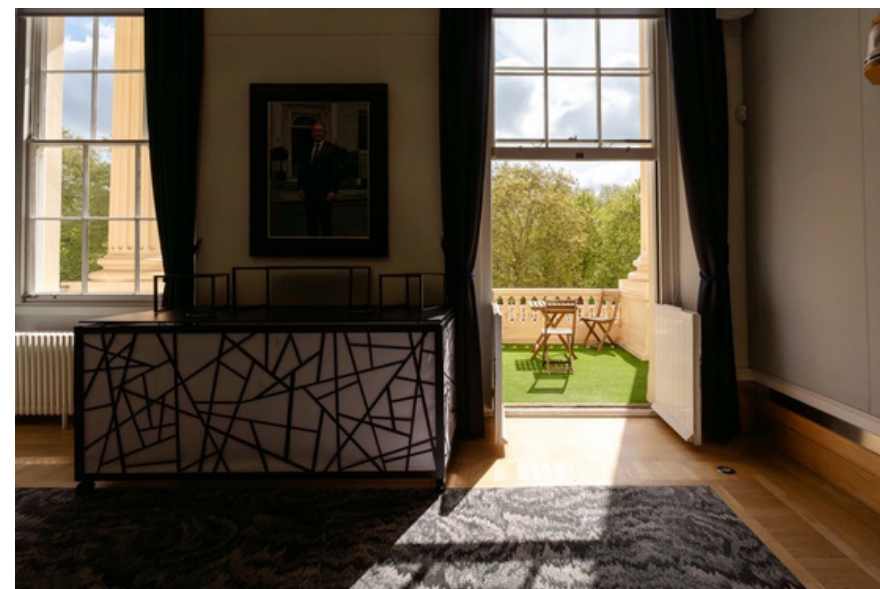
THE MICHAEL BISHOP FOUNDATION ROOM

The Ground Floor is made up on four near identical event spaces: The Rolls Royce, Sir Kirby Laing, National Grid and The David Sainsbury.



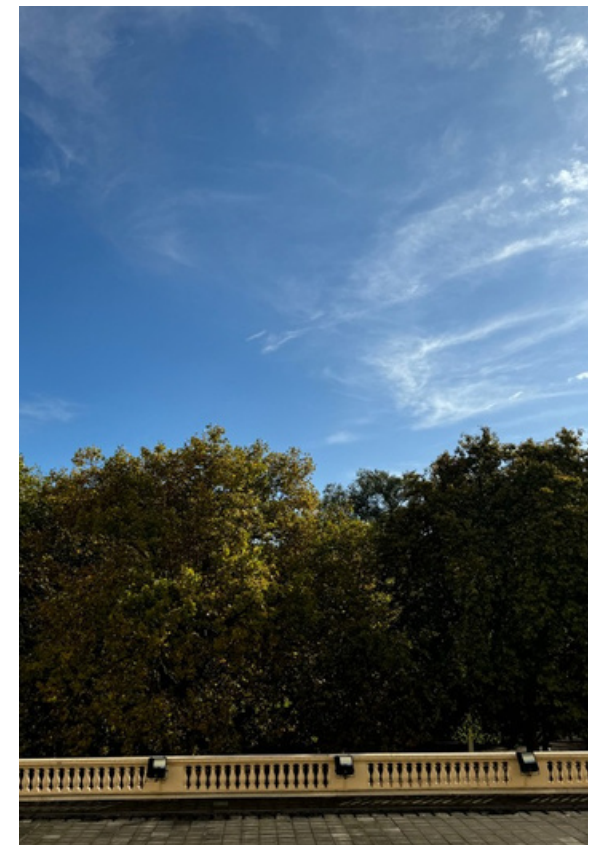

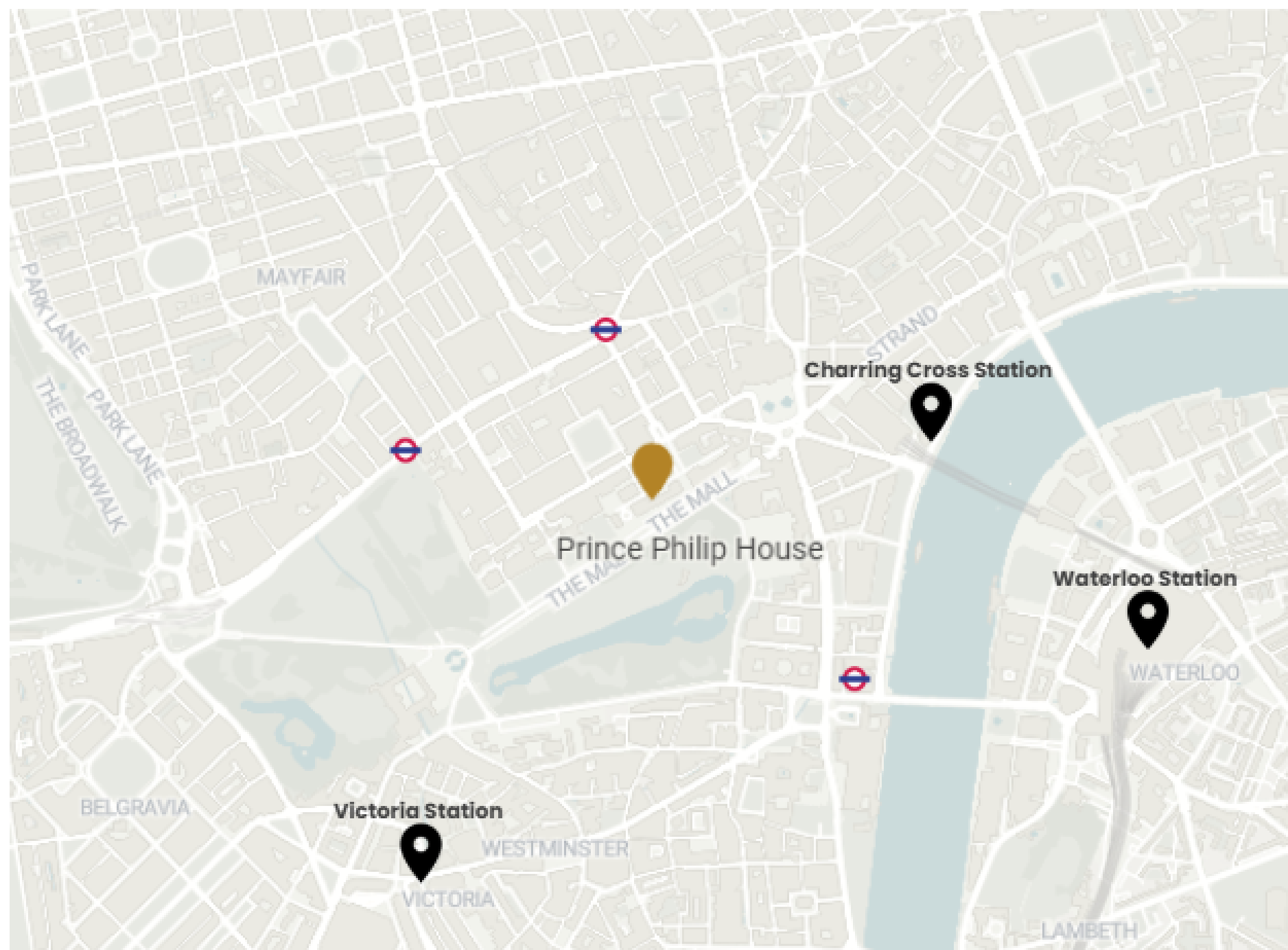
